IGOR, F₁



- ▶ medium late, high yielding variety
- ▶ vigorous growth, approx. 80 cm high, particularly stable
- ▶ the sprouts are dark green, firm, smooth and of uniform quality from top to bottom
- ▶ very good robustness against frost, healthy
- ▶ suitable for hand picking as well as for machine picking

- ▶ forms high-arched, finely scarred flowers, long harvest period
- ▶ suitable for the resale of seedlings
