

# Long Radishes

## Hybrid Varieties

### LANCELOT, F<sub>1</sub>

- ▶ slender, shiny white Japanese radish with extremely smooth surface and a root length of approx. 40 cm
- ▶ stable foliage base, mild taste
- ▶ uniform hybrid with excellent harvesting rates

### GAWAN, F<sub>1</sub>

- ▶ uniform hybrid for summer cultivation
- ▶ approx. 40 cm long, very smooth and slender bulbs with a white head and a compact foliage base
- ▶ high harvesting rate

### LORENZ, F<sub>1</sub>

- ▶ semi-long selection (approx. 25 – 30 cm) with hot radish flavour, robust against bolting
- ▶ very smooth, white bulb, dark green foliage
- ▶ this productive variety grows quickly and does not become pithy or ligneous
- ▶ very easy to harvest because head is above the soil

### VITUS, F<sub>1</sub>

- ▶ pure white, long radish hybrid with entire leaf margins and spicy taste
- ▶ only for **summer cultivation**, no formation of green head even when overripe
- ▶ extremely smooth, approx. 25 cm long, cylindrical root with improved robustness against Verticillium
- ▶ fast development (comparable to Lorenz, F<sub>1</sub>)

### HI 15 301 RER, F<sub>1</sub>

Seeds for trial cultivation. Filed for registration.

- ▶ new breeding of medium-length radish
- ▶ very white, approx. 25 cm long, cylindrical root with entire leaf margins and spicy radish taste
- ▶ only for **summer cultivation**, no formation of green head even when overripe
- ▶ improved robustness against Verticillium

## Open-pollinated Varieties

### OSTERGRUSS ROSA 2/FRÜHLINGSGRUSS

- ▶ dark pinkish, semi-long radish, ideal for bunching
- ▶ homogeneous breed for open field and greenhouse production
- ▶ standard variety for professional growers
- ▶ compact, dark foliage, easy to bunch up

### RUNDER SCHWARZER WINTER (round) (HILD's special breeding)

- ▶ dark black, round winter radish with very firm flesh
- ▶ good storability

### REX

- ▶ fast-growing, homogeneous, semi-long radish for selling in pieces or as a bunch with low tendency to pithiness
- ▶ delicately spicy taste
