

Celeriac

PRINZ



- ▶ light-skinned celeriac for the fresh market and industry, very robust against bolting
- ▶ suitable for early cultivation under foil or fleece as well as for open field production
- ▶ round bulb, comparably smooth, with little tuberous base
- ▶ dark green, approx. 40 cm high, very upright leaves in ideal relation to the bulb
- ▶ excellent white colour and firm internal quality, suitable for production of large bulbs

MARS



- ▶ light-coloured, large, smooth, high-round celeriac with dark green, upright foliage
- ▶ therefore remarkably high robustness against septoria
- ▶ suitable for bunching and as bulbs, for the fresh market and for industry cultivation
- ▶ very well suited for storage

REX

- ▶ light-skinned, particularly vigorous variety and therefore extremely well-suited for producing large bulbs for the fresh market and for industrial use
- ▶ increased robustness against septoria due to the strong foliage
- ▶ smooth bulbs with an excellent internal quality

MONARCH



- ▶ light-skinned standard variety for fresh market and industry cultivation
- ▶ heavy, large bulbs with deep-lying, tuberous base
- ▶ excellent white colour and firm internal quality
- ▶ unsusceptible to iron spots
- ▶ stays white during cooking
- ▶ very well suited for storage



PRESTINUN PILLS and PRESTINUN SEED ROLLS should be stored after receipt – until sowing – in the refrigerator. The storage period usually totals at least **3 weeks**. Please note the printed **best before date**.

MATRIX

IR: Foc, Pt.

- ▶ upright, intermediate type with slight bulb swelling
- ▶ very vigorous growth with dark and robust foliage
- ▶ convinces with uniformity and robustness against bolting



Matrix

DAMAST

- ▶ bunching onion with very dark green, tight, upright foliage and a white shaft, good for bunching
- ▶ high harvesting productivity due to uniform, medium-coarse plants and a high cleaning efficiency
- ▶ compact growth habit for the year-round open field season
- ▶ very good keeping quality on the field and good plant health
- ▶ not winter hardy



Summer Onions

STURON



- ▶ round, yellowish brown, long-day onion for production of onion sets and onions, medium early
